On Sunday, April 23, during the Sunday School hour, we are privileged to hear Armstrong Okeyo and his wife, Christine, who will be speaking on behalf of the PAIS Project Kenya Ministries. The PAIS Project is a bridge between schools and churches. With offices on 6 continents, it trains, equips, mentors, and resources Youth Pastors, plus offers a FREE Apprenticeship in Youth and Schools Ministry. PAIS places full-time teams in churches for a year at a time. Apprentices then work in both the schools and churches, equipping students to change their school and community. Armstrong Okeyo and his wife, Christine, currently lead the PAIS Kenya Ministry. Passionate about outreach and discipleship among children and teens, he believes in people and works to help them achieve their God-given potential. As a missionary in Kenya for the past 15 years, he has helped many churches repurpose their ministries. His vision is to see the lives of students transformed from the inside out and to see students become more like Jesus Christ.

As soon as a decision has been made, an e-mail note will be sent to the Presidents of the Adult Sunday School classes to advise which class will serve as "host" for Mr. Okeyo. 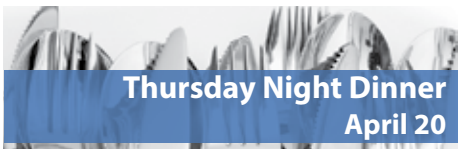
