"Do Something" Day Meal Packaging Event, January 16, 2017

Trinity has been involved with a hunger-relief ministry called *Stop Hunger Now* since 2014. This non-profit organization, which was founded in 1998, packages food and other items for distribution to people in developing nations. This year, on MLK Jr. Day, January 16, members of Trinity and several visitors joined together at our church's Activity Center to once again package meals with Stop Hunger Now. We have now named this annual event *Do Something Day* because the mission service that we perform in packaging meals is similar to the mission service our members and friends offer during our annual *Do Something Week* that we sponsor each August. Over 100 people of all ages packaged 10,368 meals in a little over an hour. Each meal that we packaged cost Trinity 29 cents to produce. The funds for the meals that were packaged on January 16 were given through the offerings received at the three Christmas Eve Worship services here at Trinity. We thank God for this wonderful opportunity to serve in such a way that will alleviate hunger and starvation in some parts of our world.

Mark Winter's One Man Show, created and performed by Rev. Mark Winter, an ordained United Methodist clergyman and a member of the Central Texas Conference, is a dramatic presentation of evangelism. Rev. Winter helps to break down barriers and give a fresh perspective on the old, old story of God's love through humorous vignettes and complete costumed monologues.
